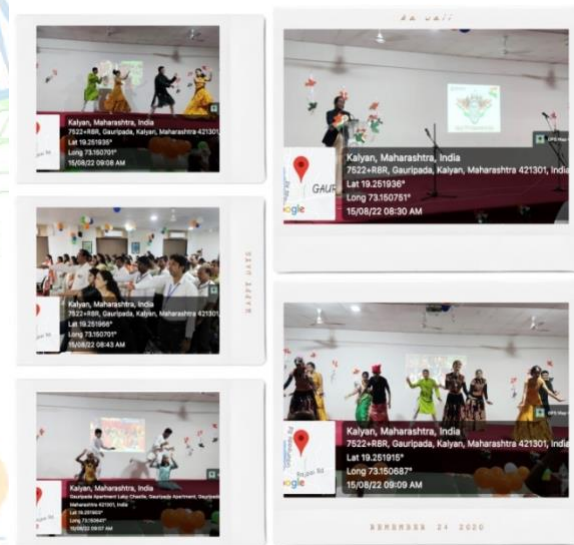
Workshop Attended by M.Ed. Students 14/8/2022

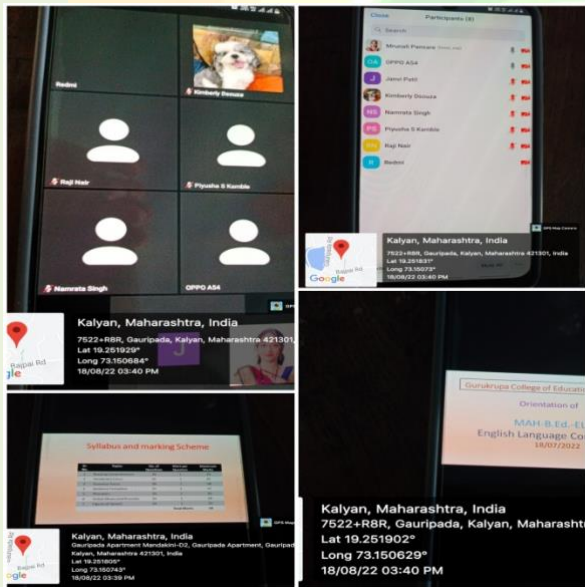
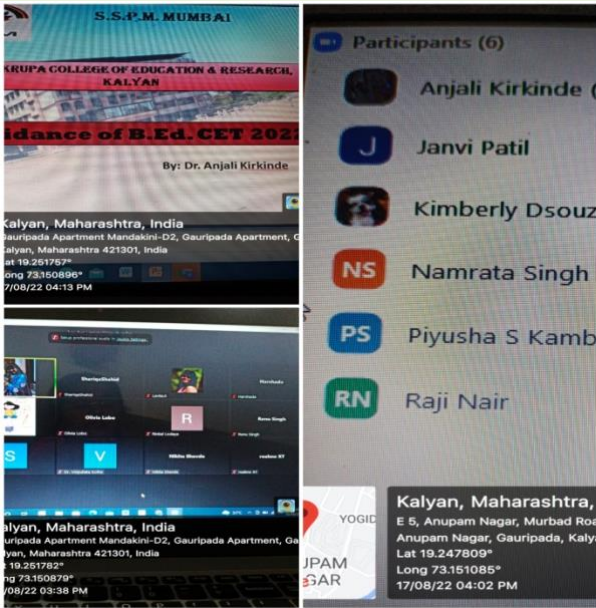
College Inspection 17/8/2022

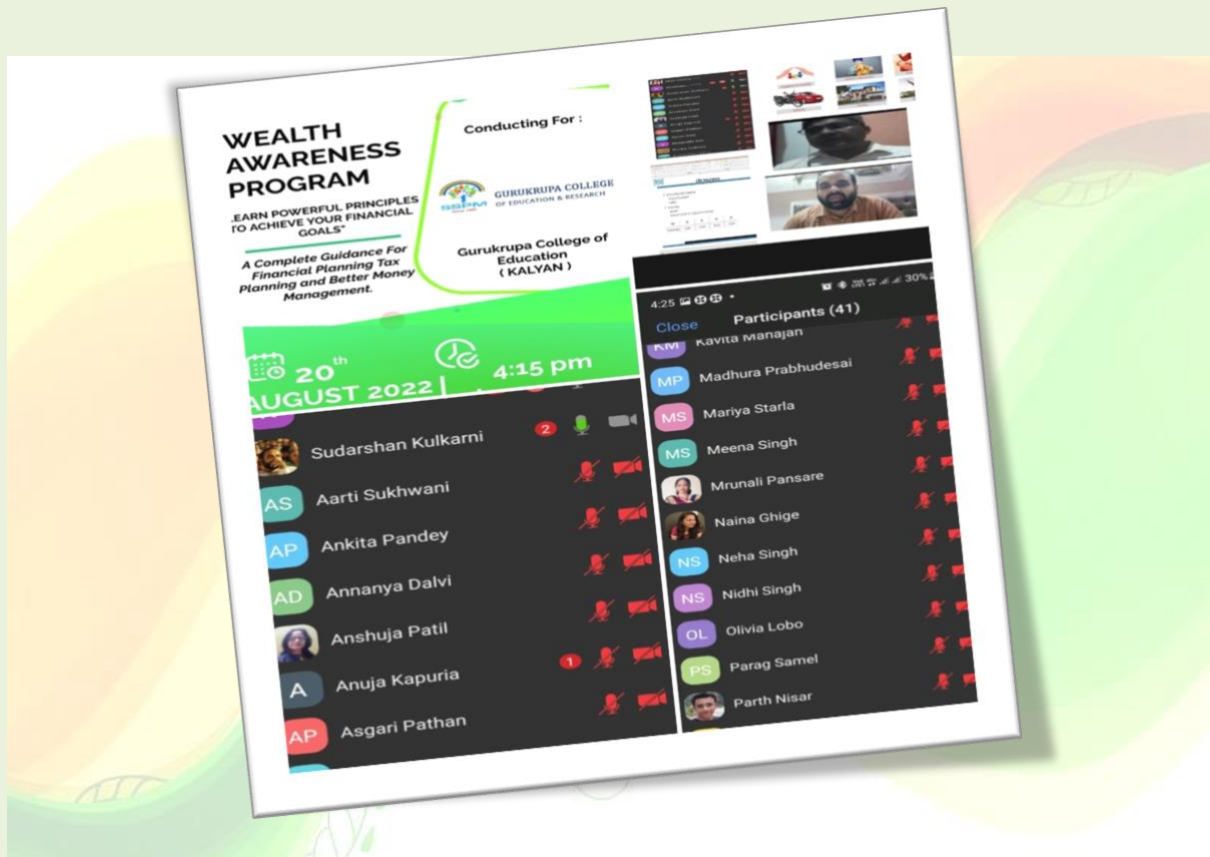
Shri Krishna Janmashtami 18/8/2022

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Webinar on “Wealth Awareness Program” 20/8/2022



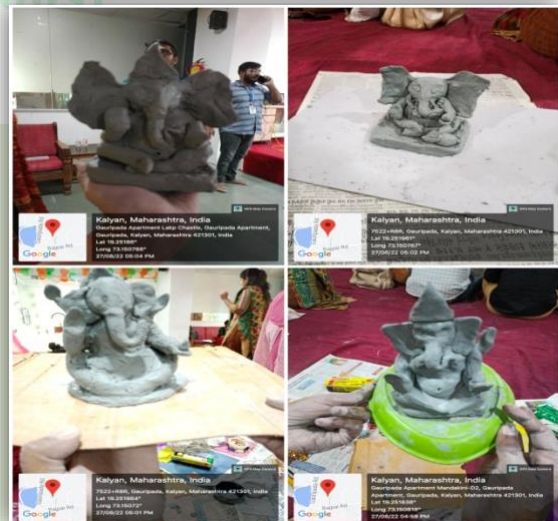
