**These are some of the glimpses & Short Reports of the activities we have taken during the month of January. Expecting same co-operation from all of you in future.**



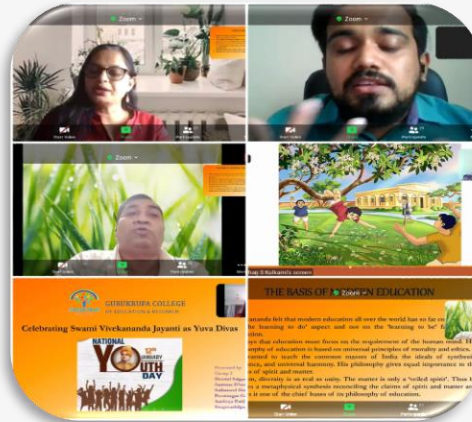
## Savitribai Phule Jayanti 3/1/2022

# Youth Day & Rajmata Jijabai Jayanti 12/1/2022



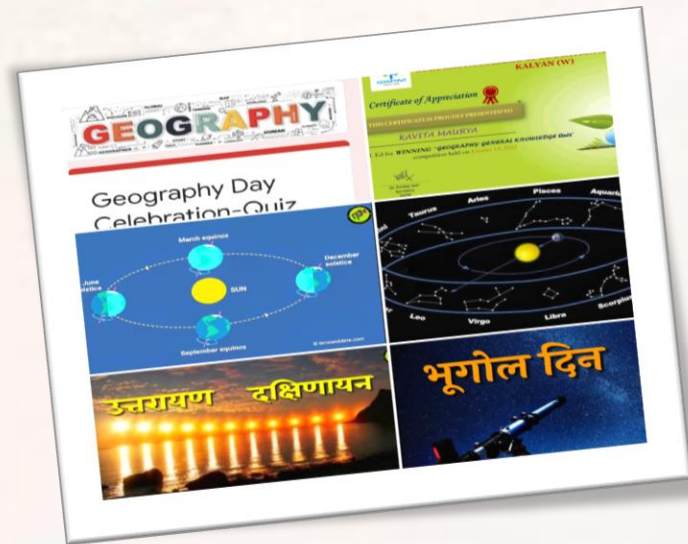
## YOUTH DAY

# Elocution Competition

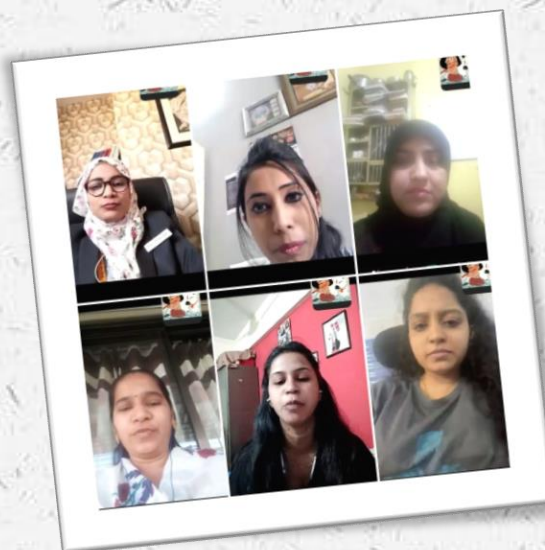
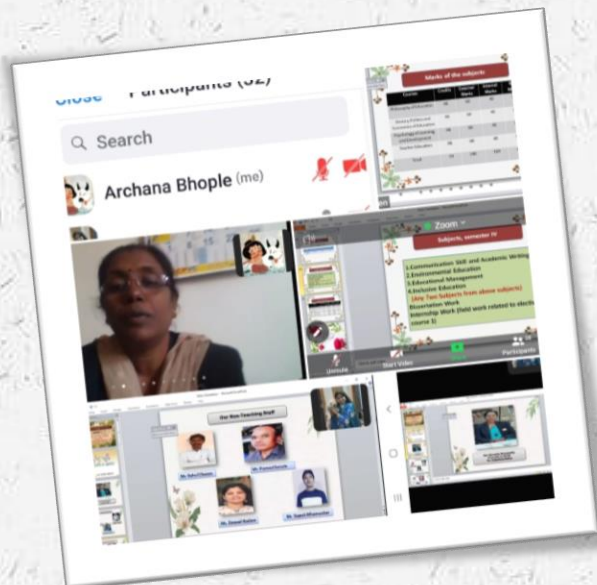
## 26/1/2022



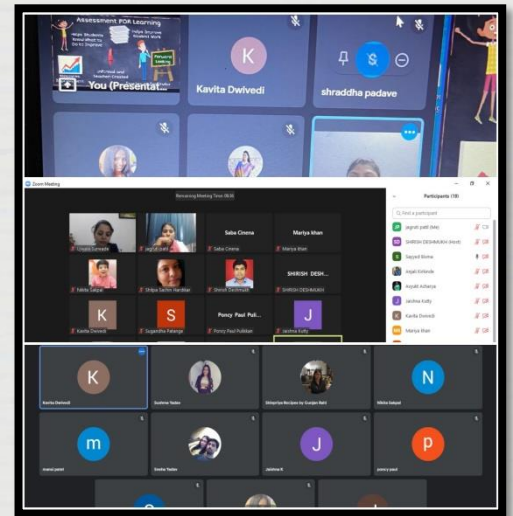
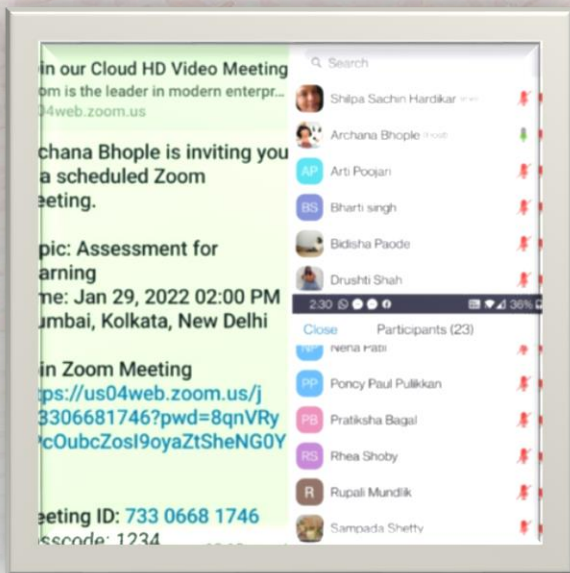
