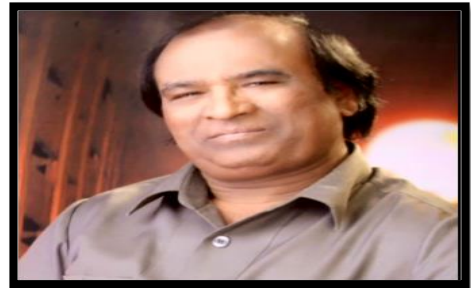

- To make aware the students the changing role of teachers in current scenario

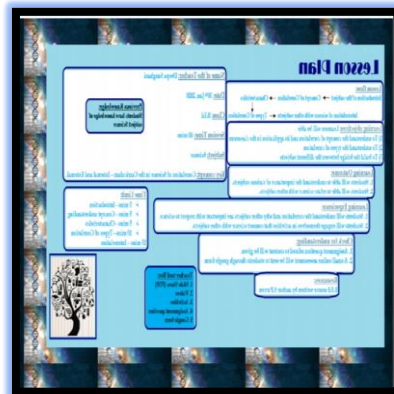

- To develop competencies required for being a reflective teacher educator.

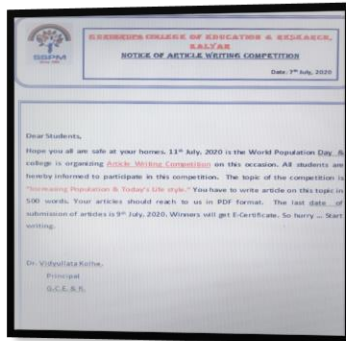

- ✚ To adopt eco-friendly clay for making Ganesha Idols

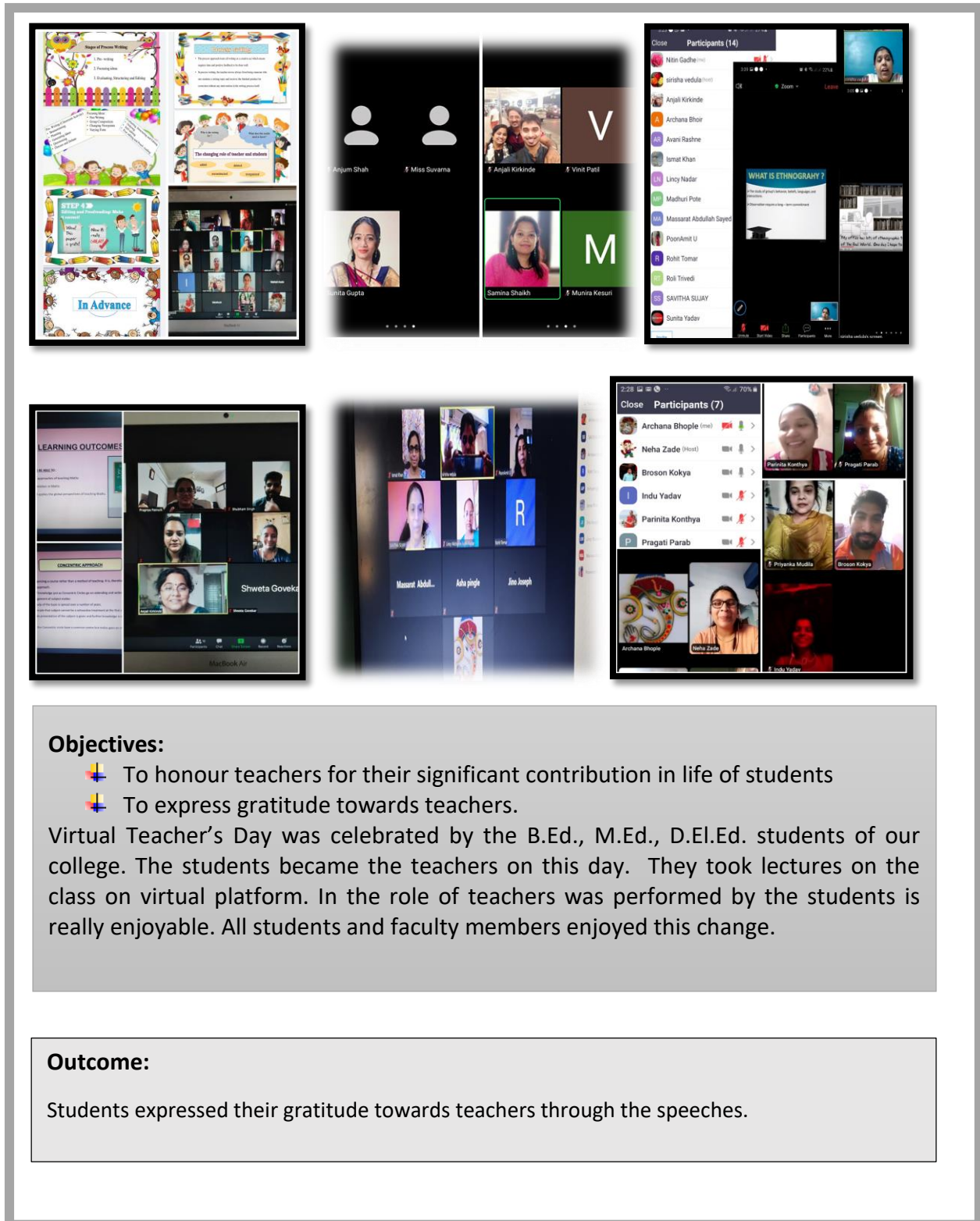

Students expressed their gratitude towards teachers through the speeches.

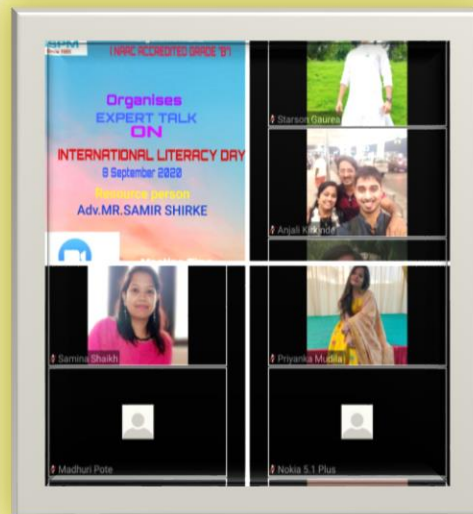
Teacher's Day Celebration (5/9/2020)

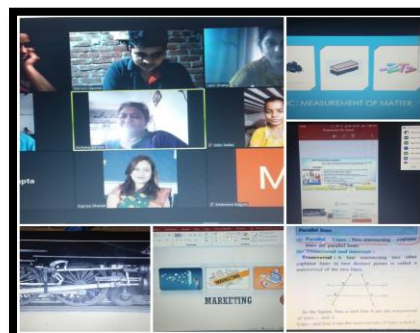
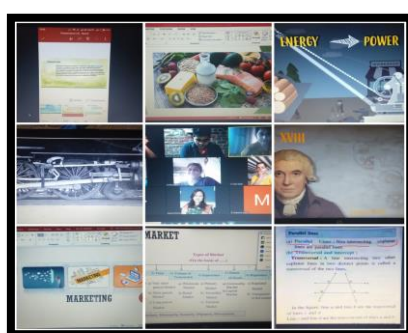

- ❖ To make our present generation aware of Lal Bahaddur Shashtri's greatness.

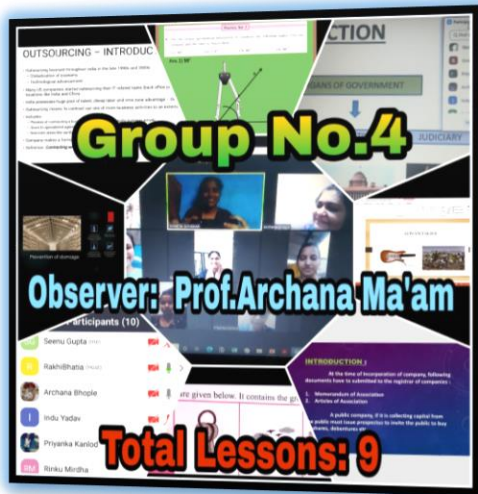

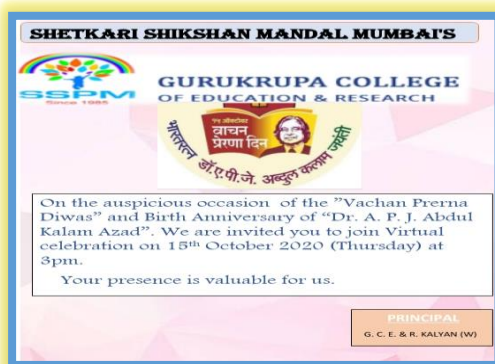

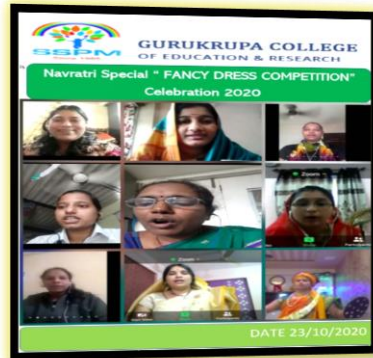

- To teach students the process of organizing competition in the classroom.

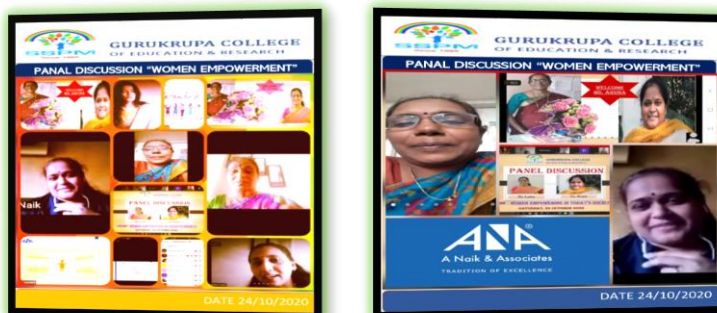

Session 4: My Family and Me

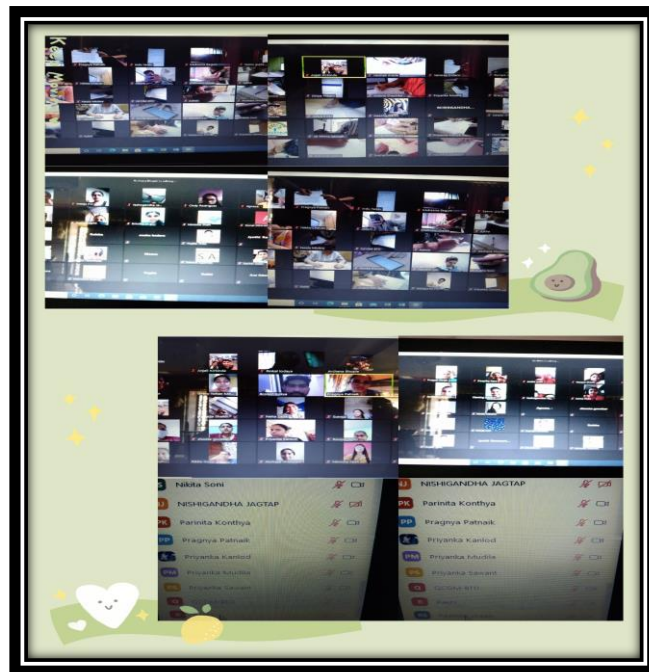

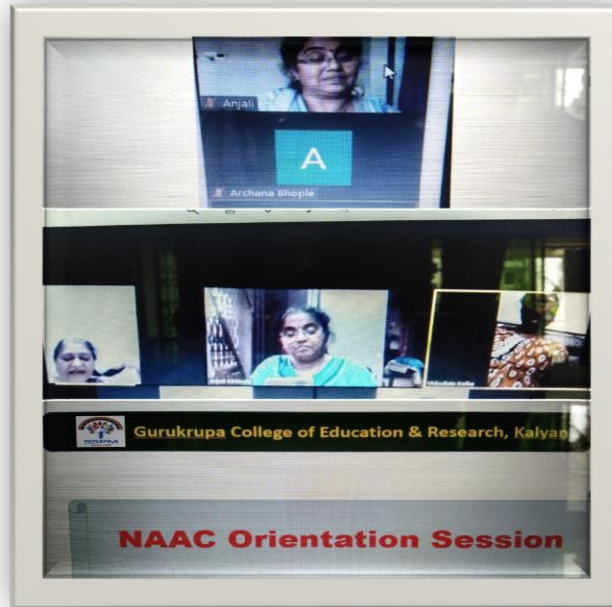

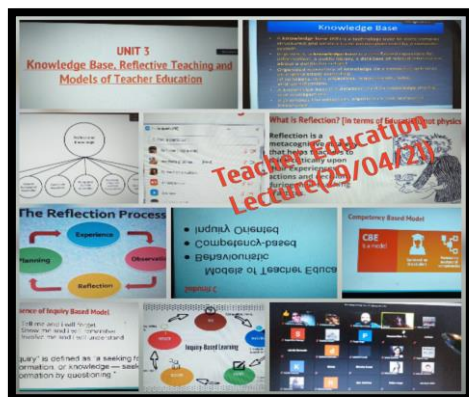
Objective:

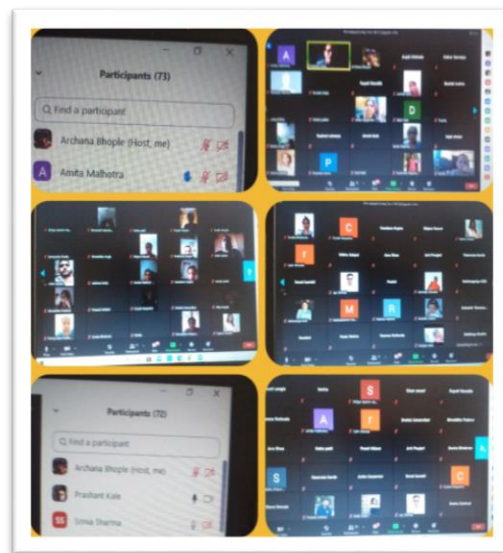
Outcome: Faculty Members understood how to file AQR report online.

(20/5/2021 to 24/5/2021)



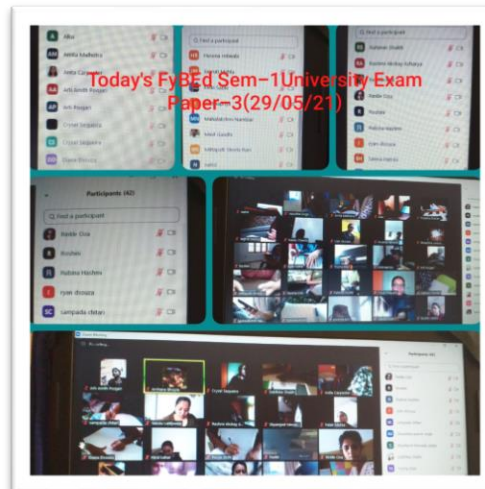
