- To promote good mental and physical health of students through yoga.

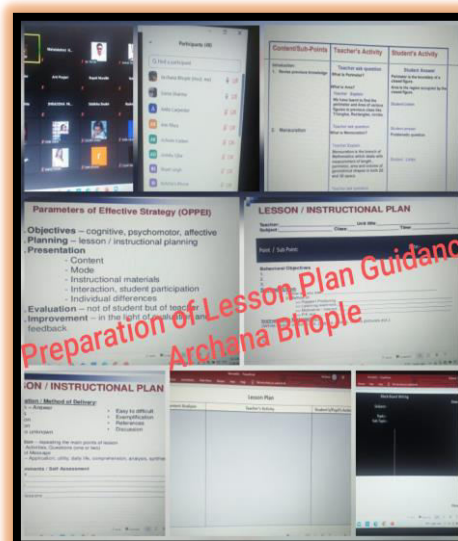
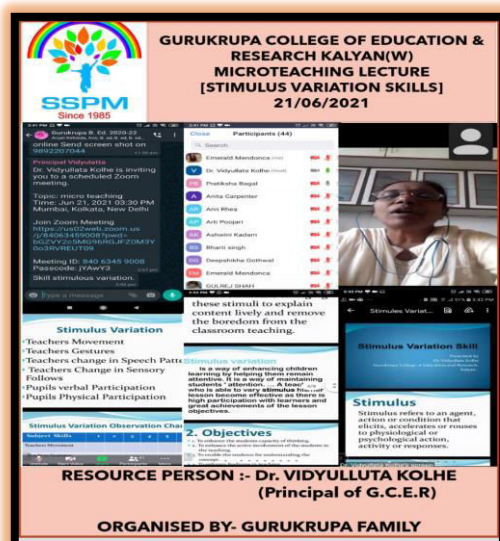

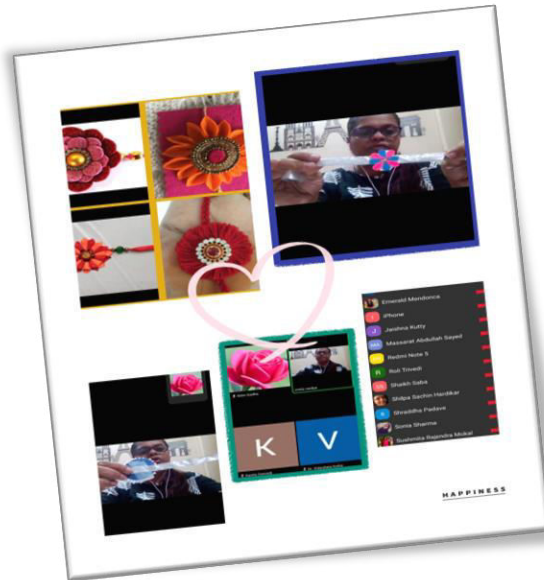
- To know the students about history of our nation & about the people who sacrificed their lives to us peaceful nation

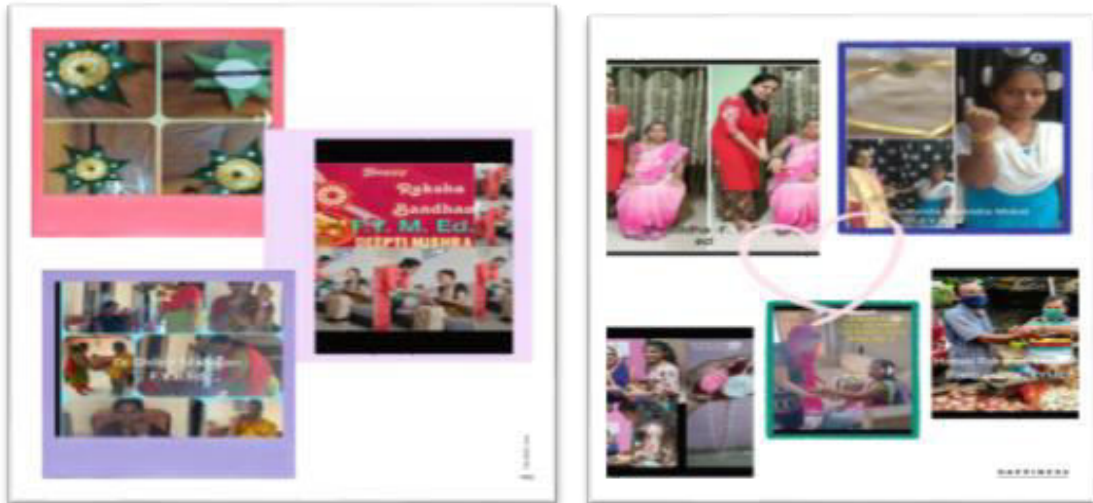

- ❑ Take a photograph while tying Rakhi send it on the group with name on 22nd Aug.

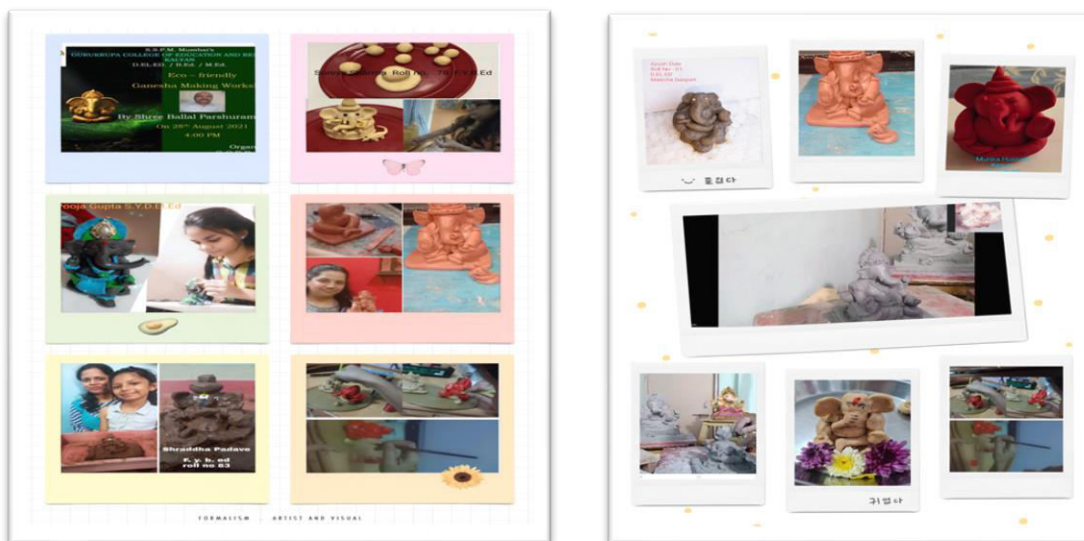
After receiving photos from the students, we prepared video of those photographs. The response for this new trend was amazing.

- To celebrate Christmas with joy and in happy environment.

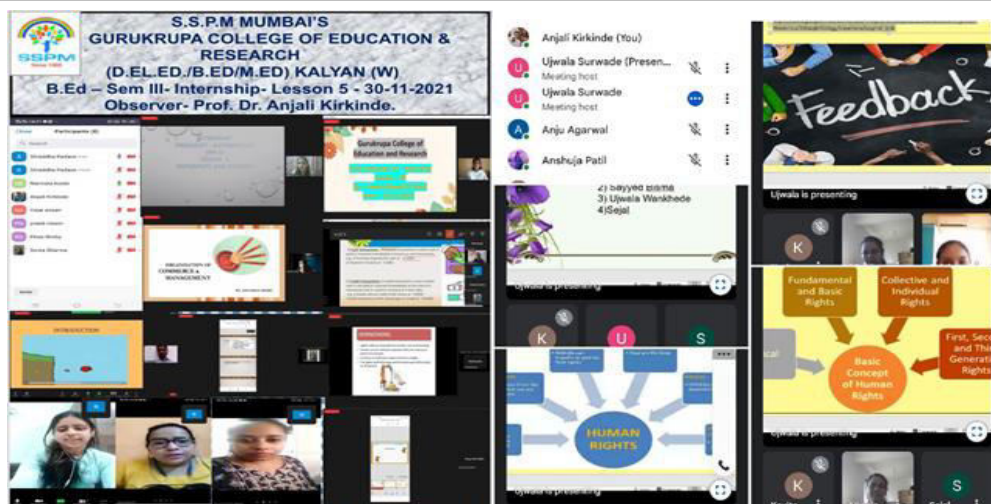
