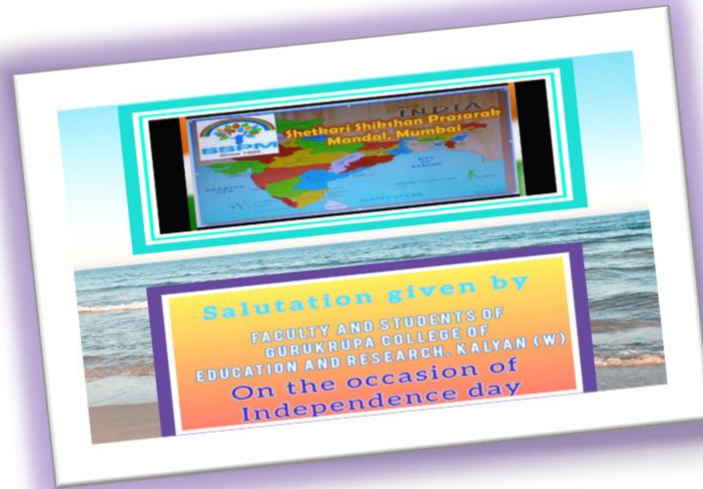
## Independence Day Celebration (15/8/2020)
